

Patient Instructions Following Wart Treatments

General Information: The treated area may be painful up to three days. It may or may not blister or turn black.

Discomfort: You may take Aspirin, Tylenol or other over-the-counter pain relievers as directed on the package, if necessary. If the pain and discomfort are not controlled adequately, then contact our office.

Removing the bandaid: You may remove the bandaid the next day and continue activity to tolerance. If the area blisters or turns black, apply Neosporin and cover with bandaid.

Signs of infection: If the treated area becomes red, painful, hot, swollen or has red streaks, contact the office immediately. You may need to be seen by the doctor and/or given an oral antibiotic prescription.
